The LES Power Board voted last night to suspend the \$130 charge for damaged equipment due to the February 2019 flood. Anyone that has already paid that charge will be given a credit on their bill and those who have not just disregard the charge. There will be a new policy coming in the near future to address installation of equipment and damages of LES facilities along the Tennessee River due to flooding events.

LES in continuing with restoration efforts, at the present time LES is able to maintain the reconnection of services in a timely enough manner to not bring in outside help. LES is trying its best to stay one day behind the State inspector. The goal is to reconnect the services that he inspects the day before.
